## CERAMIC SUNSET NECKLACE AND EARRINGS

## Materials

.018" Diameter Bright Beadalon 49 22-Gauge Hematite Artistic Wire

- 6 Ceramic 18 mm Rounds
- 12 Turquoise Nuggets
- $16^{\prime \prime}$ strand of 4 mm red rounds
- 2 Silver/Aqua Teardrop Charms
- 2 Large Silver Hammered Rings
- 2 Silver Multi-Strand Spacer Bars
- 16 Silver 14 mm Large-Hole Spacers
- 2 Silver 8 mm large-hole Spacers
- 18 Silver 6 mm Spacers
- 8 Hematite 10 mm Jump Rings
- 2 Silver Ear Wires
- 4 Silver \#1 Crimp Beads

Tip: You can use the wire-wrapping technique with 4 mm beads and geometric rings to make pendants, drops, dangles, embellished toggle rings and more. It's a very versatile technique!

## Necklace Instructions

1. Cut a 8 " length of wire and coil the end around the hammered ring. Pass through a 4 mm bead then wrap it around the ring. Continue wrapping around the ring, adding beads as you go.
2. Once you add the last bead that will fit onto the ring, coil once around the ring to secure it.
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a matching ring.
4. Use a medium mandrel with Hematite wire to make a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ coil. Cut it in half.
5. Use a thin mandrel with hematite wire to make a $2 \frac{1121 "}{\prime \prime}$ coil. Cut it in half.
6. Cut a $12^{\prime \prime}$ length of beading wire and pass the end through a crimp bead.
7. Pass the wire around the beaded ring, pass the end back through the crimp bead. Crimp it.
8. Pass the wire through a medium wire coil and a red bead.
9. Pass through 6 mm spacer, nugget, 6 mm spacer, red, 14 mm silver, red, 6 mm spacer, ceramic, 6 mm spacer, red, 14 mm silver, red.
10. Repeat the pattern twice more, then pass through: 6 mm spacer, nugget, 6 mm spacer, red, 8 mm silver.
11. Pass through a Crimp Bead and a thin coil, then pass through the 8 mm silver bead as shown.
12. Tuck the crimp bead inside the 8 mm silver bead and use chain-nose pliers to squeeze it flat.
13. Cut a 4 " length of wire and make a large wrapped loop to attach it to the 14 mm large-hole bead.
14. Pass through a 6 mm silver, nugget, 6 mm silver and make another wrapped loop.
15. Slip the wrapped loop onto a Jump Ring and open the ends wide to press them into the lower holes on a multistrand spacer bar.
16. Attach a different Jump Ring to the upper holes on a multi-strand spacer bar.
17. Cut a $3^{\prime \prime}$ length of wire, make a wrapped loop to attach it to the jump ring from step 16.
18. Pass the wire through a 6 mm silver, nugget, 6 mm silver and make another wrapped loop.
19. Use a Jump Ring to connect the wrapped loop from step 18 to the second beaded ring.
20. Repeat Steps 6-19 to complete the necklace.

## Earrings Instructions

1. Connect a Jump Ring to the loop on the teardrop charm. Attach it to a 14 mm large-hole bead.
2. Cut a $3^{\prime \prime}$ length of wire, pass it through the large-hole bead, then cross the wires above the bead so one wire is shorter than the other.
3. Coil the short wire 3-4 times around the other wire.
4. Pass the long wire through a 4 mm bead and 6 mm spacer, then make a small loop about $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ above the bead.
5. Coil the wire around the base of the loop, down toward the spacer.
6. Attach an Ear Wire to the upper loop on the dangle.
7. Repeat Steps 1-6 to make a matching earring.
