GOLDEN MEMORY WIRE BANGLES

Materials

- Beadalon Gold Color Bracelet-Size Memory wire #347A-050
- Bead Gallery beads: 2 gold color 1-1/2" sliders, 2 gold color 1" sliders, 16 antique copper 6mm rounds, 8 antique brass 6mm rounds, 16 gold 3mm rounds
- Beadalon Tools: Nylon Round-Nose Pliers #JTNJ4 (or memory wire pliers), Memory Wire Cutters #JTMEMCUT2
- 7-1/2" bangle

1. Use memory wire shears to cut a 1-1/2 loop of bracelet-size memory wire; repeat.
2. Make a basic loop on one end of each of the wires.
3. Pass one wire through the upper holes on a 1-1/2" slider and one wire through the lower holes. Make sure the wires are extending in the same direction.
4. String the following beads onto each of the wires: copper, gold, brass, gold, copper.
5. String the corresponding holes of a 1" slider onto the wires.
6. Repeat the beading pattern from Step 4.
7. Repeat Steps 3-6 once more.
8. Check to make sure the bracelet fits over your hand. See the tip for adjusting the size.
9. Bend each wire in a basic loop after the last bead. Cut off any extra wire.
10. Connect the end loops on the upper wire and the end loops on the lower wire to complete the bangle.

Tip: To adjust the size of the bangle, change the beading pattern between the sliders by adding more small beads to make a larger bracelet or by removing beads to make a smaller bracelet.
