## MAGENTA TASSEL NECKLACE \& EARRINGS

## Materials

Necklace - Any length
22-gauge Hematite Artistic Wire \#AWD-22S-19-8YD
Silver Small Beadalon Cable Chain \#340B-001
7 Silver Beadalon Medium Ball Head Pins \#312B-253
Hematite Head Pin
40 mm Teardrop Magenta Stone Bead
8 pink 6 mm Cat's Eye Rounds

- 12 mm Faceted Black Glass Round
- Magenta 6 mm Shell Round

Earrings - 2 1/2" long

- 22-Gauge Hematite Artistic Wire \#AWD-22S-19-8YD
- Silver Small Beadalon Cable Chain \#340B-001
- 2 Silver Ball Ear Wires \#308B-007
- 2 Silver 25 mm Solid Rings

Tools
Round-Nose Pliers \#201A-104
Chain-Nose Pliers \#201A-101
Wire Cutters \#202A-105
Nylon Jaw Flat-Nose Pliers \#JTNJ3

TIP: This is a casual, quick necklace! For a more dramatic version, make several pendants and attach them in a cascade to the center of the necklace.

## Necklace Instructions

1. Pass a silver head pin through a pink round and make a wrapped loop; repeat for all of the pink beads.
2. Pass a hematite head pin through a magenta round and make a wrapped loop.
3. Cut five $2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths of chain.
4. Cut a 6 " length of wire and make a wrapped loop to attach the chains. Pass through the magenta teardrop, all of the beaded head pin loops, black round and make a wrapped loop.
5. Cut a $3^{\prime \prime}$ length of wire and coil it around the base of the teardrop and downward over the loop that's holding the chains.
6. Cut two lengths of chain to the desired necklace length and pass them through the upper loop on the pendant.
7. Cut a $3^{\prime \prime}$ length of wire and make a wrapped loop to attach one end of the chains together.
8. Pass through a pink bead and make another wrapped loop to attach the other end of the chains.

## Earrings Instructions

1. Cut two lengths of chain: one $1^{\prime \prime}$ and one 1-1/4".
2. Cut a $3^{\prime \prime}$ piece of wire and make a wrapped loop on one end to attach the chains.
3. Pass through a pink bead, make another wrapped loop to attach the beaded dangle to the silver ring and ear wire.
4. Cut a $2^{\prime \prime}$ length of wire and coil it around the silver ring.

Press the coil with nylon-jaw pliers.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a matching earring.
