## PEARL DOUBLE STRAND BRACELET

## **Materials**

- 118 Beadalon® Artistic Wire® 18g 15/64" TR Silver Plated Jump Rings A314-18S-10-10
- 76 Beadalon® Artistic Wire® 18g 9/64" TR Silver Plated Jump Rings A314-18S-10-05
- 126 Beadalon® Artistic Wire® 18g 1/8" TR Silver Plated Jump Rings A314-18S-10-04
- 2 Beadalon® Small Toggle Clasps
  - Silver Color 323B-001
- 1 Strand Pre-Strung Pearls Michael's
- 1 Artistic Wire® Basic & Advanced Chain Maille Booklet by The Chain Maille Lady JBKCHML03

## Tools:

- 2 Pair Beadalon® Artistic Wire® Snub Nose Pliers by The ChainMaille Lady™
- 1 Paper Clip

- 1. Separate each pearl into a pearl component with two loops on either end of the pearl.
- 2. Using the 18g 15/64" and the 18g 9/64" jump rings make two chains of Parallel Weave according to the book "Basic & Advanced Chain Maille" by The ChainMaille Lady.
- 3. Using the two small toggle clasps and the 18g 1/8" jump rings attach the circle ends of the clasp using one 18g 1/8" and the "T" ends of the clasp using three 18g 1/8" jump rings.
- 4. Place one 18g 1/8" jump ring through the space where the three 18g 15/64" jump rings intersect.
- 5. Repeat step 4 all the way down one side of the parallel chain.
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the second parallel chain.
- 7. Using one 18g 1/8" jump ring scoop up two neighboring 18g 1/8" jump rings added in steps 4 and 5, before closing scoop up one loop on one pear component. Close the jump ring.

















- 8. Repeat step 7 all the way down the one parallel chain.
- 9. Using one 18g 1/8" jump ring scoop up two neighboring 18g 1/8" jump rings added in step 6, before closing scoop up the loop of the first pearl component added in step 7. Close the jump ring.
- 10. Repeat step 9 joining the parallel chain and pearl components of the first parallel chain to the second parallel chain.
