FARRINGTON NECKLACE

Materials

- Wire Shears
- Chain Nose Pliers
- 1.25mm Metal Hole Punch
- 17 inches Gold Filled Cable Chain with @2mm rounded links.
- 9mm Gold Filled Lobster Claw Clasp
- 2 4mm Gold Filled Open Jump Rings
- One 6mm Gold Filled Closed Jump Ring
- 19 6mm Bronze or Antique Brass 20 Gauge Jump Rings
- 3mm Flat Artistic Wire in Silver Plate, Gold Plate and Hematite

1. Cut the 3mm Flat Artistic Wire using metal shears as follows:
 - a. Hematite – 19 pieces measuring 1.25 inches
 - b. Gold Plated – 19 pieces measuring 7/8 inches
 - c. Silver Plated – 19 pieces measuring 5/8 inches
2. Using sandpaper carefully file the edges of the Flat Artistic Wire pieces to smooth out the ends.
3. Using 1.25mm metal hole punch, punch a hole at the top center of each piece of cut wire.
4. Starting at the center link of the necklace, attach the pieces of flat wire using your jump rings and chain nose pliers. Attach the ring to the chain first and then slide on the wires starting with the longest piece and ending with the shortest.
5. Continue adding the wire until all 19 sets are on the necklace making sure to keep them centered!
6. Add a 9 lobster claw clasp and 6mm closed jump ring to your chain using 4mm open jump rings and your necklace is complete!
